For some years now the church at St Teilo's has observed an annual prayer week, with special events to encourage us to pray.

This year our prayer week will run from **Sunday May 28 to Sunday June 4 (Pentecost)**. This means that we can join with the global prayer movement called, "*Thy Kingdom Come*", initiated by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York in 2016, and which runs again this year from Ascension Day (May 25) to Pentecost.

The purpose of "*Thy Kingdom Come*" is to pray for more people to become Christians. This is vital not just for the future of the church but for the wellbeing of those for whom we pray, friends and family members among them.


Jesus is very clear in the gospels that, whether or not people realise it, every single human being needs the forgiveness and new relationship with God which only His death and resurrection makes possible for us. If we truly care about people we must therefore pray that they will come to know Him, and take the opportunities which come our way to tell people about Him.

You will find prayer cards at the back of church containing an invitation from the Anglican and Roman Catholic bishops in Wales to give "**10 minutes for 10 days to the Kingdom of God**", and suggesting how this can be done. We can do this either individually in our own time, or in conjunction with the events being organised for prayer week.

Easter propels us forward to Pentecost. In every generation what Jesus has done must be made known to an unbelieving world so that, in the words of Jesus (Acts 26:18), people have the opportunity to **turn "from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they**

may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.”
