In this period between Easter Day and Pentecost we follow the story of the first Christian disciples and how they changed from being disillusioned, demoralised and defeated after the events of Maundy Thursday and Good Friday to being people who were used by God to bring many others to life-changing faith in Jesus.

Genuine Christian faith has always shown itself in lives changed for the better. We are told, "**Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind**" (Romans 12:2), and such transformation is made possible by the Holy Spirit, who comes to live in us when we turn to Christ and works within us to challenge and to change us into what we're meant to be (2 Corinthians 3:18).

On Tuesday May 14 we will begin a new four-part course called, "*There Are No Ordinary People*".

The course is presented on DVD by Jeff Lucas and is based on his book of the same title, which looks at what we can learn from the life of Barnabas, one of the greatly respected but less well known figures in the early church.

Jeff Lucas is a witty and enjoyable speaker to listen to, and his aim is to help us see how "*in the midst of the ordinary we can live extraordinary lives with God.*" If we are to be faithful disciples of the risen Jesus, and if the churches in our communities are going to grow again, then this is clearly what we must be able to do. Had the first disciples believed the lie that they were far too ordinary to make any difference to the world then there would be no Christians today. I hope you will make the most, therefore, of this opportunity to be encouraged and better equipped in your discipleship.
