

## When will services be held?

There will be services in St Teilo's at 11.30am on Sundays.  
The first service will be held on Sunday 11th October.

## What do I need to know before I attend?

- If you are unwell, or if a member of your household is unwell, you should NOT attend a Church service.
- **Prior to attending you will need to book a place each time you wish to attend. To do so you will need to contact Michael and Sally Sadler on 01558 823862 or [mssadler@macunlimited.net](mailto:mssadler@macunlimited.net)**
- Bookings will be on a first-come basis and you will not be able to book earlier than the Tuesday before each service, or make a permanent booking.
- We will request details and these will be kept for three weeks for test and trace purposes.
- Places are limited due to the social distancing requirements (20 household groups).
- If you have not secured a place in advance, you will NOT be admitted if all of the spaces have already been booked. For those unable to get a place, we will be continuing our online provisions, and you will be offered a place for the next available service.

## What can I expect?

- On arrival, you will be met by a steward who will confirm that you are not experiencing any symptoms prior to entering the building.
- Please enter the building via the normal, main entrance.
- As you enter, you will be asked to sanitise your hands and a steward will ensure that your details are on the attendee list.
- Not all pews / seats will be in use. To maintain social distancing, you will be directed to a seat.
- Please come early, ensuring that you are in your seat at least 10 minutes prior to the service.

- Singing is not currently permitted.
- In accordance with new Government guidance for indoor public spaces, you MUST wear a face covering, unless you are exempt.
- When the service is a Eucharist, this will be by one kind (bread only). It will be administered after the vicar has sanitised his hands and he will be wearing a face covering.
- At the end of a service, please remain seated until asked to leave by a steward.
- You are welcome to bring an offering and this can be placed in the wooden collection box at the back of the church. We would like to discourage the use of cash, to prevent people from having to count and handle money. Please consider giving a cheque, or better still to support the Church by giving online (please contact the Church Treasurer for details).
- Please exit following the one-way system. As you exit, you will need to sanitise your hands.
